If a shot is taken before a price is advised, the client is liable to pay the full confirmed price of the animal if it is retrieved. If the animal is missed or is wounded/not retrieved, the client is liable to pay the guide's approximated price of the animal.

Wounded/not retrieved animals – 100% of approximated price of the animal

Clean miss – 75% of approximated price of the animal
